Report of Day 3 Hindi – “Role of Literature to Society”

Symposium for day 3 was held on the topic “Role of Literature to the Society” was held on 23rd March 2022.

The lecture was given by Dr. P. Rajaretnam., Associate Professor and H. O. D. of Hindi, Thiruvarur University.

The session started by 9:35 A. M. in the morning. Dr. Prema of the Department of Hindi proposed the welcome address followed by introduction of the speaker.

Dr. Rajaretnam began his lecture by explaining the lecture’s title “Role of Literature to the Society” quoting Dr. Acharya Vishwanath who puts forth the idea ‘Sahitya Samaj Ka Darpan’ which means literature mirrors the society. Sir further explained how civilisation, culture and time are inter woven in the great matrix of literature. The use of Rasa Aesthetics in Hindi and Tamil literature was duly dealt with lot of references to great epics like Ramayana, Mahabharath and Tamil epics like Tholkaapiyam and Kambaramayanam. The essence behind the novels of Premchand is Realism which brings to light the struggles of a common man with no masking of reality behind the flair of imaginative thinking. The lecture also focused on the notion of Vasudevakudumbagam and the importance of familial virtues and values which are the inevitable links that keeps our society from degeneration. Sir elaborated on Hazarprasad Drivedhi’s views on social justice, freedom, unity, brotherhood which helps us understand about the people around us with a sense of empathy. Tamil poets Thiruvalluvar, Bharathi and Lyricist Vairamuthu’s ideas were compared and contrasted to elaborate the importance of humans as an individual being who are very much connected to the society one lives in, which has a telling impact on ones being. The lecture concluded with a discussion on the poetry of the Bhakthi movement poets like Rahim and Kabir Das.

The Q & A Session was curated by Dr. Prema and Ms. Indra where the speaker shared his thoughts and insights on the questions posted. The session came to an end with the Vote of Thanks delivered by Ms. Indra.
