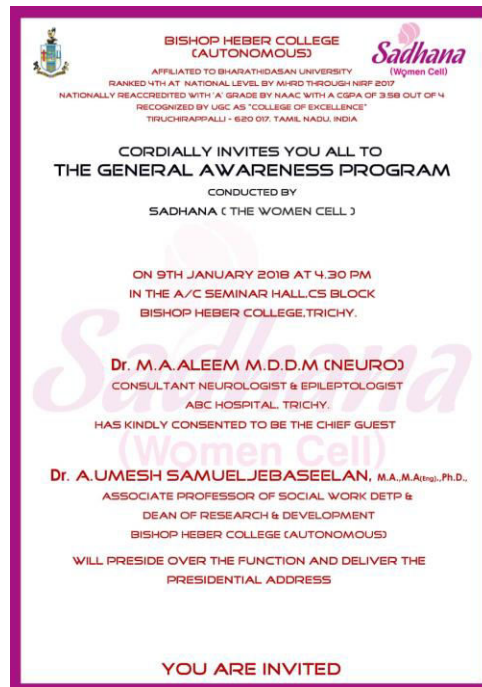
Sadhana –Women’s Cell

Dr. Seetha Lakshmi, Associate Professor of Economics emphasized the importance of education. The students of Department of Zoology conducted blood tests for the school students and recorded the following 'O+': twenty five, 'O-' :one, 'AB +': two, 'B+': seven, 'A+': ten. Besides analysing the blood group, the students of zoology also analysed and found that around 80% of the school children are anaemic. Ms .Rosalind, Assistant Professor of Nutrition and Dietetics educated the children about the diseases related anaemia and the appropriate diet for cure. The students of Computer Science, Computer Application and Information Technology taught the school children about the important features of laptop and how to use it. The students of Chemistry highlighted the importance of hygiene, conducted short games and gave prizes. The Fine Arts students entertained the children with their graceful dance. The extension activities ended with the prize distribution by Sadhana, along with the sponsoring of note pads and pens by Varun's Marketing.



Top Slip: A team of twenty eight professors attended a Two Day Workshop, Ecology at Topslip under the leadership of Dr. A. Relton, Vice Principal of Self-Financing Section, Head & Associate professor of Social Work on 10th , 11th February 2018, at Topslip, Anaimalai. The trainees were made cognizant about the diversity of forests and pathetic state of the forest which is on the verge of extinction. Ms . Ajella Gayathri, Research Scholar of our college and daughter of Retd. Forest Officer brainstormed about the remedial measures to be taken in order to preserve the forest. It is noteworthy that her field of research is grounded on that. Besides this the delegates also learnt about the breeding and maintenance of elephants and strategies used by human beings to tame them.
