Guidelines for Registration and Paper Submission

- A maximum of two authors is permitted.
- The Registration must be done separately by Author and Co Author.
- Papers must be presented either by the author or Co-Author or both through online.
- Abstract should not exceed 150 words and full paper should not exceed 7 pages.
- The paper must be neatly typed in MS-Word with Times New Roman, font size 12 and with 1.5 line space.
- The title of the paper, name of the Author, designation, institution address, mobile number and E-mail should be mentioned for each author.
- Soft copy of the paper is to be sent to <u>commerce@bhc.edu.in</u>
- Registration fees can be paid only online, through NEFT.
- Participation Certificates will be given to all registered participants.
- The papers will be selected for publication only after plagiarism check. The selected papers will be published in UGC CARE list of journal Group I or Scopus/Web of Science.
