THE LIBRARY

The communication skills of all the Undergraduate Students are honed by providing personalized learning pace in the English Language Lab, which is equipped with highly configured systems.



STUDENT COUNSELLING CENTRE

The Centre offers a variety of services to the students such as Counselling Assessment, Crisis Intervention, One-to-one Mental Health Counselling, Referrals, Nutritional Counselling, Group Counselling and Workshops on various Psychological Issues. Students are encouraged to meet the counsellor for redressing their psychological, emotional, academic and adjustmental problems.
