



Linkage with Government and Non-Governmental Organizations

The department having celebrated its silver jubilee celebrations, had over the years, developed a strong network with Government departments and NGO's primarily through the field work training of our the Social Work students. We are in regular contact with agencies working for children, the differently abled, women, rural and urban developmental projects, industries, medical and psychiatric Hospitals. Several community based programmes are being organized by us in collaboration with these organizations. Many of our alumni are employed in these agencies which facilitates our collaboration with them.

PROGRAMMES OFFERED

M.Phil. in Social Work - Both full time and part time postmaster's research programme. Any postgraduate degree holder in social work is eligible to apply.

Men. Ph.D. in Social Work - Both full time and part time. Any MSW or M.Phil degree holder in social work is eligible for entry.
