

BISHOP HEBER COLLEGE

Bishop Heber College is a Religious Minority Educational Institution established by the Tiruchirappalli – Thanjavur Diocese of the Church of South India. Its main objective is to cater to the higher educational needs of the Christians and students of other faiths and religions. The College offers UG, PG, M.Phil and Ph.D programmes under Aided and Self-Financed Sections without compromising the quality.

The College Coat-of-Arms bears the Rock in Tiruchirappalli, a Cross and a Bible surmounted by a pelican feeding its young with its own life-blood drawn from its bosom. The pelican stands as a symbol of Christ and the Eucharist. The Motto "Nisi Dominus Frustra" is from Psalm 127 of Holy Bible. The whole verse runs thus: "Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it".

Bishop Heber College has its roots dating back to 1864 when it was established as S.P.G. College. In 1923, it was renamed Bishop Heber College in honor of Reginald Heber's profound impact on education and missionary endeavors in India. Over the years, the college expanded its academic offerings, becoming a prominent institution in Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu. The Most Rev. Dr. Solomon Doraisawmy, who was the consecrated Bishop of Tiruchirappalli-Thanjavur Diocese in 1964, succeeded in reviving the College on June 24, 1966. The College started offering programmes in the Self-Financed stream from the year 1985. In 2004, Bishop Heber College attained autonomous status from the University Grants Commission (UGC), a milestone that underscored its commitment to academic autonomy and innovation. The revived College celebrated its Silver Jubilee in February 1992 and Golden Jubilee in 2016.

The College now offers 10 Under-Graduate programmes, 07 Post-Graduate programmes in the Aided stream of study besides research programmes leading to M. Phil and Ph. D programmes. The College offers 29 Under-Graduate, 19 Post-Graduate and 01 Integrated PG programme in the Self-Financed stream from the year 1985 onwards. The College has already established a great reputation for its high academic standards and attracts students from all over India and abroad.

THE LIBRARY

The Library of Bishop Heber College serves as a catalyst, facilitating the user community's scholarly exploration, learning endeavours, and the generation of novel ideas. Its wealth of robust information resources dedicated to teaching, learning and research plays a pivotal role in connecting individuals with intellectual growth and innovative pursuits. Library's current holdings include 1,28,779 books, 555 rare books, 222 print periodicals, 1917 non-book materials, 479 theses, 10 newspapers, 31,35,000+ e-books and 6000+ e-journals. The subscribed electronic resources can be accessed from off-campus also.



The Library is fully automated using NIRMALS & KOHA Open Source Library Management Software integrated with RFID technology, Self-Service Kiosk & Web OPAC. The Library functions from $8.30~\rm am$. to $10.00~\rm p.m.$ on all working days.





LANGUAGE LAB

The Language Lab functions throughout the year on all working days to facilitate language acquisition and is available to students and teaching staff for efficient use. The Language Lab trains more than 3500 people annually, including students and special groups, and is one of the most active learning centres on the college campus, where learning takes place continuously throughout all working days. The high-end digital language lab can offer the best features that a regular classroom can never deliver, like virtual reality, visualization, giving tailored education, and individualized assessments.





IT FACILITIES

Centre for Data and Information Services (DIS) provides IT resources to sustain and enhance the academic and administrative activities of the learners, teachers and support staff of Bishop Heber College. The Institution provides 24/7 free Wi-Fi and has 144 ICT-enabled classrooms with desktop computers/laptops and LCD projectors. All 144 Classrooms and 12 Seminar Halls are equipped with ICT facilities, and there are 20 Science Laboratories, 20 Computer Laboratories, 14 Research Laboratories and 2 exclusive Computer Laboratories for advanced research. Faculty members created 562 e-contents, 200 blogs, and a knowledge repository portal and uses various software to advance digital and programming skills amongst the young leaders. Lecture capturing systems, video-conferencing facilities, and smart boards are available.







DEANERY OF TRAINING AND PLACEMENT

The Deanery of Training and Placement of Bishop Heber College serves as the nodal point of contact between the students and like emplover agencies the Corporate Sector/Educational Institutions and the Banking & Accounting sectors. The Deanery offers a course on 'Life Skills' for all the Undergraduate (UG) students in the Fourth Semester and hones their skills, making them job-ready. The Deanery organizes training sessions on Communication, Career Guidance and aptitude and Technical Skills required to meet the changing needs of the employment sector. The Deanery has a library with a collection of books, journals, software to aid communication skills and study materials for competitive examinations and an exclusive training hall. The Deanery fetches students their dream jobs when they exit the campus.



SPORTS AND GAMES

Bishop Heber College has a variety of sports facilities available for its students. The college sports team participates in various sports and games, including cricket, football, basketball, hockey, tennis, table tennis, chess, powerlifting, weight lifting, and best physique. The college teams in these sports have been champions of Bharathidasan University and of other organizations for many years. The college has an air-conditioned fitness center with modern equipment for students' exclusive use. Additionally, there is a state-of-the-art air-conditioned Indoor Stadium with international specifications for playing badminton, volleyball, and table tennis.

- 4. Application Number & Register Number allotted to the candidate are not transferable.

- 6. Candidates should fill-in the application and upload the following mandatory documents:

- 7. For UG: +2 Examination marks should be filled-in as soon as the results are published.
- 8. For PG: Candidates must fill-in upto their 5th Semester marks and Engineering students must fill-in upto their 7th semester marks.

- 9. Hard copy of the Application is not acceptable.

- Candidates joining B.Com (International Accounting) should pay an additional amount of Rs. 45,000 at the time of admission and Rs 6,000 per semester for ACCA
- Candidates joining B.Com (Strategic Finance) should pay an additional amount of Rs. 42,000 at the time of admission and Rs 25,000 in the III semester for US CMA
- Candidates joining B.Com (FinTech) should pay an additional amount of Rs 18,000 every semester for NSE Academy
- Candidates joining B.Com (Professional Accounting) should pay an additional amount of Rs 25,000 at the time of admission and Rs. 5,000 per semester for CA/ CMA coaching
- Candidates joining B.BA. Aviation & Ground Handling and B.Sc. Aviation should pay an additional amount of 20000/- per semener & 24,000/- per semester respectively for Madras Flying Club Aviation Academy for Internship

Note:

- UG & PG Students shall have to pay an additional amount for the Add-on Programmes offered by the respective Departments.
- For Part-1 Language in UG Programme, Candidates are permitted to choose only the Language they have studied either in HSC or in X standard as Part 1.
- ☑ If an UG student likes to study a Language other than Tamil, ie. Hindi/Sanskrit / French under Part -1 Language, he/she should pay 2,600/-per year.
- Christian students should pay an additional amount of ₹400/- per year for the Value Education events.
- PG Students from other Universities (within Tamil Nadu and Outside Tamil Nadu) should pay an additional amount of 1,250/-, and students from other Countries should pay an additional amount of 10,000/-as University Fee.

- Those admitted to the Self-Financed Stream will not be transferred to the Aided Stream on any account.
- No fee (except the Caution Deposit) is refundable, if a student leaves the College after the reopening date for the academic year 2024-2025.
- √ 10% of the fee paid will be deducted towards the administrative charges and the balance amount will be refunded if a student leaves the College before the reopening date.
