History and Development

- **Origins:** BHC traces its beginnings to Heber Memorial High School (est. 1864), initially known as S.P.G. College. It was the first college in Tiruchirappalli.
- **Early Milestones:** Honours courses in History and Mathematics began in 1925. The institution was renamed Bishop Heber College in the late 1920s and celebrated a Diamond Jubilee in 1926 under the then Governor of Madras, Lord Goshen.
- **Revival and Growth:** After merging with Madras Christian College for a period, BHC was revived on June 24, 1966. From 1966–1969, it ran pre-university classes at Teppakulam, and in July 1968, it was upgraded to a degree college offering History, Economics and Mathematics. The College expanded into self-financed programmes from 1985 and hosts an accredited IGNOU Study Centre since 2002.

Our Library houses 1,32,994 books, 555 rare books, 197 print periodicals, 1,917 non-book materials, 532 theses, and 11 newspapers, along with a vast digital collection of 31,35,000+ e-books and 14,135+ e-journals, accessible both on and off campus. Fully automated with NIRMALS and KOHA and equipped with RFID, Self-Service Kiosks, and Web OPAC, the library offers seamless access to resources. It remains open from 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on all working days, providing an enriching space for discovery and innovation.



Language Lab

The Language Lab operates on all working days, supporting effective language learning for students and faculty. Training over 3,500 learners annually, it is one of the campus's most active learning centers. - * Candidates joining B.Com. (International Accounting) have to pay the total fee of Rs. 55,580, which includes MOU fee of Rs. 29,500 for ISDC (for Semester I&II).
- * Candidates joining B.Com. (Strategic Finance) have to pay the total fee of Rs. 47,320, which includes MOU fee of Rs. 18,000 for Miles Education (for Semester I-IV).
- * Candidates joining B.Com. (Fin. Tech.) should pay an additional amount of Rs.1,200 in I, II, III & IV Semester for visiting faculty and Rs.20,060 in V & VI Semester for NSE.
- * Candidates joining B.B.A. Aviation & Ground Handling and B.Sc. Aviation should pay an additional amount of Rs.23,600/- per semester & Rs. 28,320/-per Semester respectively for Internship.

NOTE:

- ✓ UG & PG Students shall have to pay an additional amount for the Add-on Programmes offered by the respective Departments.
- ✓ For Part-1 Language in UG Programme, Candidates are permitted to choose only the Language they have studied either in HSC or in X standard as Part 1.
- ✓ If an UG student likes to study a Language other than Tamil, i.e., Hindi/ Sanskrit/French under Part-I Language, he/she should pay **Rs. 6,000/-per year**.
- ✓ Christian students should pay an additional amount of Rs.400/-per year for the Value Education events.
- ✓ UG Applicants who have studied XII std in other board/other state, should pay Rs.1,635/-for university approval and other country students to pay Rs.7,635/-.
- ✓ PG Applicants who have studied UG in other Universities (within Tamil Nadu and Outside Tamil Nadu) should pay an additional amount of Rs. 1,890/-, and students from other Countries should pay an additional amount of Rs. 10,640/- as University Fee.
- ✓ Those admitted to the Self-Financed Stream will not be transferred to the Aided Stream on any account.
- ✓ **10% of the fee paid will be deducted** towards the administrative charges and the balance amount will be refunded if a student leaves the College **before the reopening date**.
- ✓ **No fee (except the Caution Deposit) is refundable**, if a student leaves the College **after the reopening date** for the Academic Year 2026-2027.
