Student Council is Body with a definitive structure which operates in many forms under the Deanery of Academics both Arts and Sciences.

OBJECTIVES:

The following are the goals or purposes in the configuration of the Student Council:

- The Student Academic Council assigns roles to the student nominees in the Council who have outstanding academic records, excellent leadership skills and outlooks.
- The nominated students represent their respective departments while some serve as the Executives Members who are in turn decision makers in terms

of various facets of academia – curricular, extra-curricular and co-curricular activities.

- Student members are driven to reflect setting greater echelons for their departments, institution ensuring the quality, novelty and contemporaneity in curricula, teaching and learning.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The Student Academic Council assists students learn about **democracy and leadership** and implement these ideals in their respective fields of knowledge, professions and walks of life.
- The Student Council helps share students' ideas, interests and innovations with their faculty and the Principal and eventually implement their ideals in the market place scenario.
- Student members are oriented towards instructing their peers the need for inculcating in themselves loftier self-worth and expertise in their relevant fields of knowledge.
- Motivates the members in this body help raise funds for college activities including social events and community projects

STRUCTURE OF STUDENT COUNCIL

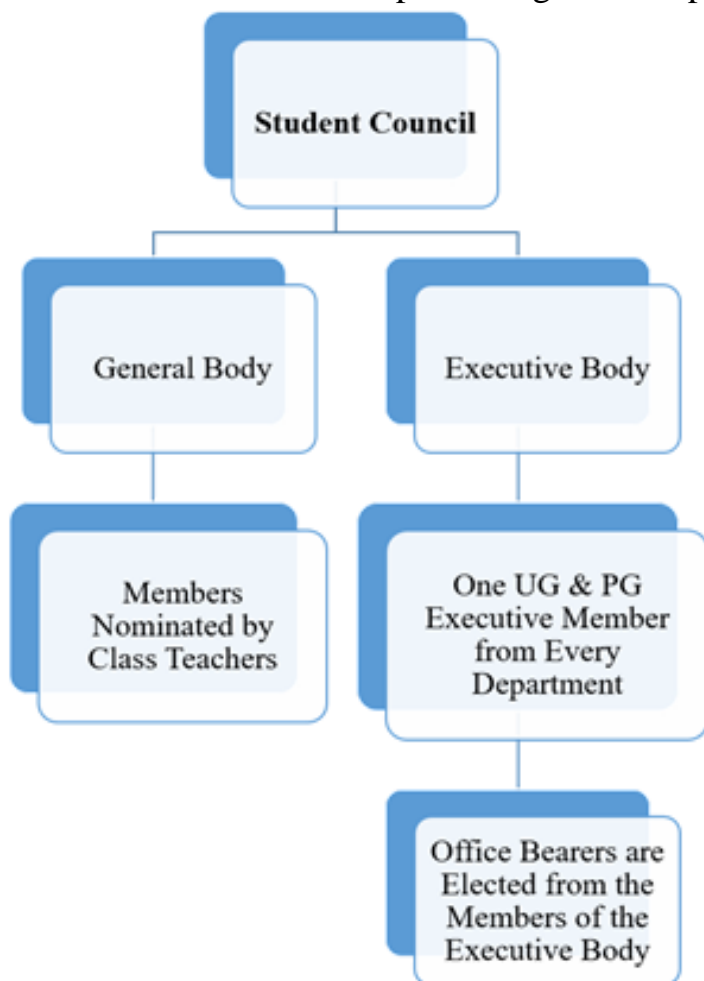
The Student Council of Bishop Heber College constitutes two Sectors

b. Student Council – Executive Body

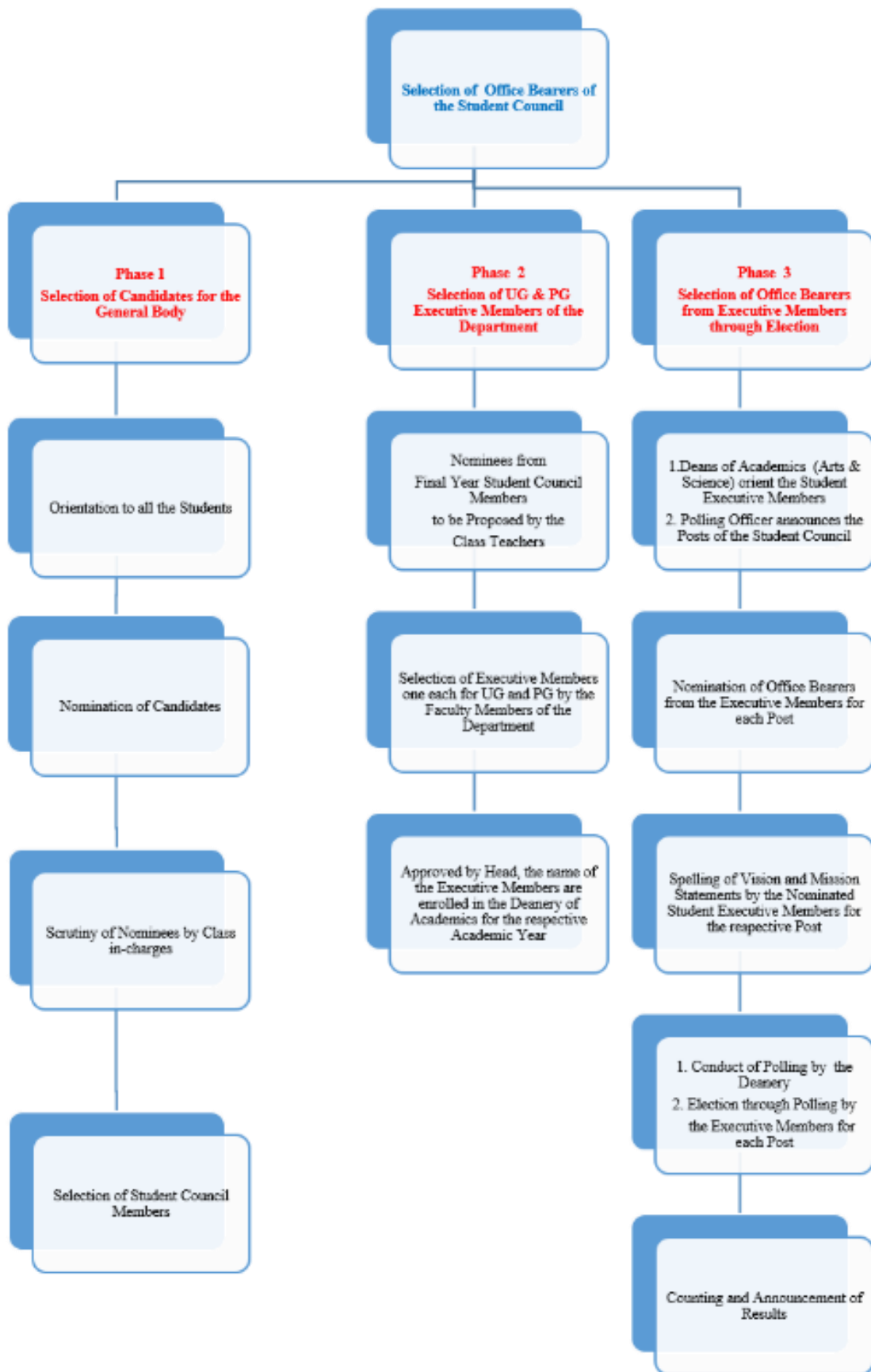
The Executive Body of the Student Council includes **one** UG and PG Executive Member representing Each Department.



ELECTION OF OFFICE BEARERS

The Office Bearers of the Student Council are elected among the Executive Members in adherence with the guidelines suggested by Lyngdoh Committee (2006)

The Office Bearers of the Student Council are elected in three Phases



Phase 1: Election of the Class Representatives

After an orientation about the roles and responsibilities of the Student Council during the General Orientation to Freshers and all the classes, the class in charges of the respective classes, get nomination from their respective classes, scrutinize them and select the class representatives affirming the overall opinion of the entire class.

Phase 2: Selection of UG and PG Student Executive Members of the Department

Among the UG and PG final year class representatives, the class in charges of the classes meet together and nominate students to serve as Executive Members of the Department, There in the Head of the Department and the faculty members of the department, discuss and finalize the Student Executive Member of the Department, one for UG and PG.

Phase 3: Election of Office Bearers from Executive Members

On the day of the election, the Dean of Sciences and Dean of Arts of the Deanery of Academics orient the students regarding the roles and responsibilities of the Student Council. A Polling Officer is nominated by the Deanery who will announce the various Posts and brief their specific roles. The Polling Officer then collect nomination for each post and conducts the election, after Spelling of Vision Statements by the Nominated Student Executive Members for the Respective Post. Polling is conducted, counted and the results are announced by the Polling Officer.





Investiture Ceremony:
