SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The Deanery of Staff and Student Welfare provides frequent orientation and guidance for the students regarding the application of various scholarships available to students. The Deanery aims for the overall development of Students by providing varied Scholarship schemes. POLICY PROVISIONS

FEE CONCESSION

Through the Deanery fee concessions for deserving students are provided every year. Special scholarships under the scheme Student Helpline and Heber hands are granted to the eligible students. Staff children are also eligible for fee concession.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE STUDENTS

A. STATE / CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AND NON – GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

- The Deanery take necessary steps to inform the students about various scholarships through noticeboards and websites, circulars and announcements through the class teachers.
- The students are insisted to approach the scholarship in-charge in the management office for collection of applications and clarifications.
- The filled-in forms of the students are checked and duly forwarded by the respective authorities to the concerned departments for processing.
- The students who are awarded scholarships are intimated through proper Channel.

B. MANAGEMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

- The Deanery regularly informs the students about Student Helpline and Heber hands scholarships funded by the college management
