It has successfully and synchronously accomplished the following tasks ensuring a heightened level of clarity and focus in the institutional functioning towards quality enhancement and promoting the institution to secure 43rd Place at the National level by NIRF Ranking during the Academic year 2020-2021.

The following activities have been organized by the IQAC of our College during June 2021 to April 2022:

 Launching of e-AQAR (HePTA - Heber e-Portal Template for AQAR) & Online Students Mentoring Portal (HOME - Heber Online Mentorship Enclave)

On July 27, 2021, a customized portal for our College prepared by the Staff and Students of the Computer Science, for Online Student Mentoring System entitled Heber Online Students Mentoring Enclave (HOME) was launched for the benefit of the Students and Staff of our College with effect from Academic year 2021-2022

• Faculty Induction Programme on Effective Teaching & Management

A two day Faculty Induction Programme was organized by the IQAC on September 2 and 3, 2021 for the newly recruited staff members in the Self-Financed Stream of our College, based on the theme 'Effective Teaching and Management'.
